## Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival Mexico City

Our staff will welcome you at the airport and transfer to your hotel in Mexico City.

## Day 02: City Tour and Anthropologic Museum

Panoramic tour by the historical downtown arrived to the 'Zocalo', visiting in the National Palace the Diego Rivera's mural (Could be close some days) and the Metropolitan Cathedral. ## Day 03: Teotihuacan and Basilica de Guadalupe
